



Dear Friends...

Two years ago I wrote in my January newsletter note about the joy of hitting the reset button on a fractious computer. Suddenly all the incompatible programming, all the corrupted files, all the conflicting commands disappear with the stroke of a key and things revert to the way they were at a time when all was compatible and everything was getting along together within that little electronic box.

Well, it has happened again. A couple of months ago I noticed my computer was running slower. Then it began to freeze up and refuse to do anything for a few minutes. Those few minutes became longer and longer until finally the only way I could get it to do anything was to shut it down, give it a rest, and bring it back up again. It was as though I had to make it sit in time out for a while and think about its misbehavior before it would be allowed to rejoin life. I tried taking it back to those happy days of good behavior, but that only worked until the updates to the operating system, which were apparently causing the problem, began loading while I wasn't looking. It was like correcting your child's misbehavior and expecting it to remain corrected when you send him or her back to school where they learned the bad behavior in the first place. It was becoming clear that I had no choice. It was time to send the offending computer back to the day of its birth. With the stroke of a series of keys I would clear its mind and change its attitude from that of a spoiled child to the blank slate of a newborn.

Unfortunately, life doesn't come with a reset button like that. We aren't machines ... we're people. We can't go back to day before yesterday and try again as if today had never happened. One day

flows into the next and we must build on what has come before so we can make the most of tomorrow. There are two things, however, which are useful and maybe even better than having a reset button. One is the new year, the other is this God we worship.

The year 2017 is upon us. The calendar has turned over a new number, and this is a perfect time to have a look at what we need to bring into the new year with us and what we can leave behind. It really is a second chance. Nothing can be undone, but it can be learned from as we go forward.

Now read 2 Corinthians 5:17, please. Paul is talking about our ministry as Christians of fixing things that are broken and making the good things even better, and in the middle he says, "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!" It would seem that we worship a God of many second chances ... a God to whom resetting things is a real possibility for those who will try.
