Dear Friends...

Nature abhors a vacuum. It's one of the oldest and most basic laws of physics. It means nature would rather fill empty spaces with something than leave them empty. That law explains why you can drink through a straw and why a vacuum cleaner works. An empty space is created, and whatever is available that can find its way in fills it. In our culture this law seems to apply to silence, also. We have a hard time with silence.

There's a game I play sometimes with groups of people. I tell everyone that I am going to time a minute and I want them to raise their hand when they think the minute is up. The rule is that silence must be kept until the last person has raised his or her hand. It usually takes about twenty seconds for the first hand to go up, and almost never does the whole minute go by in silence before all the hands in the room are in the air. We have a hard time with silence. Maybe we need to redefine it.

If asked to define silence, my guess is most folks would say silence is the absence of sound. That's true. If you take away sound, you are left with silence. But silence is not an empty space waiting to be filled like that vacuum that nature abhors. Silence is a thing in the same sense that sound is, and

a definition of sound could just as appropriately be the absence of silence. Sound and silence are two different things, and each has a place in our lives ... especially in our faith lives. Without silence we could not hear the voice of God. Throughout the scriptures God's presence is associated with earthquakes and violent winds and claps of thunder, but those things tend announce God's presence. God's message doesn't come until the noise is over and things have grown silent (see I Kings 19:11-19). We would do well to get comfortable with being silent before the Lord, as well as making a joyful noise in His presence. Both have a place in worship.


